1. **Register for an account** at <http://www.citizen.org.uk/register/>.

Choose a memorable username and password.

Please note: *usernames cannot contain spaces*.

This username will be used to access the [CITiZAN interactive map](#) and [app](#)!

Be sure to read the Terms and Conditions of being a website user and surveyor.

Click the button to send an activation link to your email address.

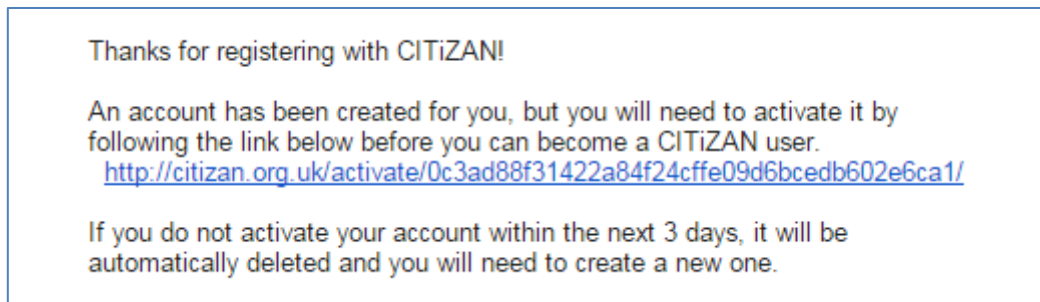

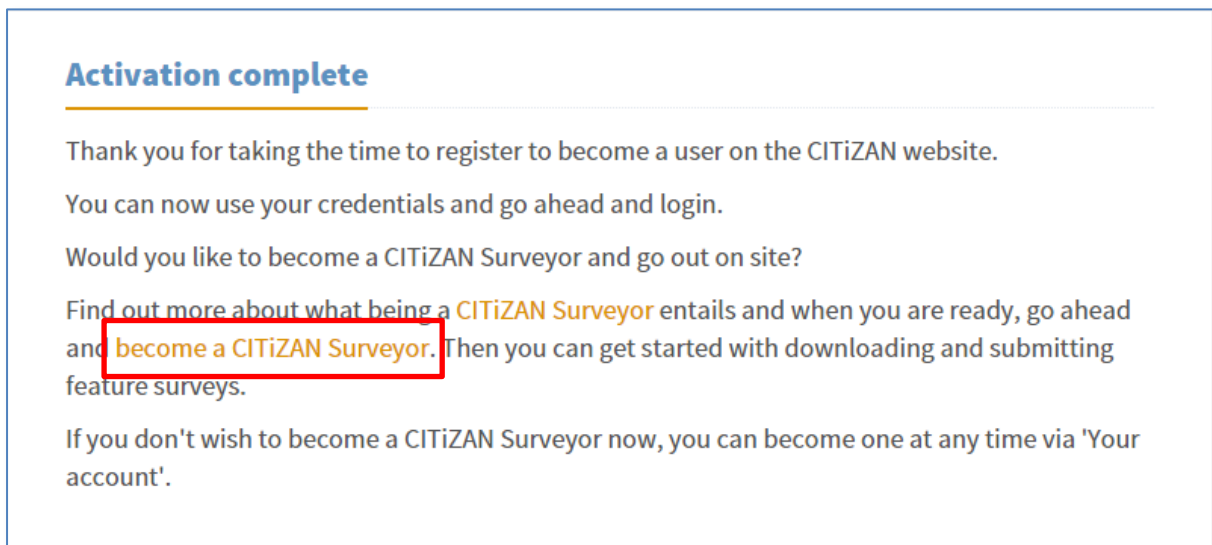
